Level 1	Is not a prerequisite for the Level 1 (advanced) course. Course is aimed at teachers / coaches who wish to, are currently working with, beginner junior level players	In-Course Work Post-Course Worksheets	7.50 hrs 5.00 hrs
Level 1 (advanced)	Is the starting point for your coaching career. This course is aimed at coaches who wish to, are currently working with, beginner / intermediate club level players.	In-Course Work Coaching Practical Post-Course Worksheets	15.00 hrs 15.00 hrs 5.00 hrs
